WHY GET INVOLVED?

- Contribute to research on psychedelic safety and outcomes
- Help shape the future of evidence-based services
- Strengthen the community's understanding of psychedelics - there are no benefits to you, directly



WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO?

- 1 **Let your facilitator know you're interested** in participating in the OPEN study.
- 2 **Your facilitator will give you a unique link or QR code** so that you can sign up.
- 3 **Before your session, fill out a 15-20 minute online survey** about your mood, substance use, and health.
- 4 **After your session, you'll complete up to 6 more surveys** over the course of 12 months. You'll receive a \$50 gift card for each survey you fill out.



HOW IS MY DATA PROTECTED?

- **Security & Privacy:** We use state-of-the-art technology to make sure all of your information remains private. This study has passed all of OHSU's strict security checks.
- **Ethical:** Research is always voluntary, you can change your mind and withdraw at any time.
- **Confidential:** Your identity is never revealed to anyone, unless required by law (e.g., in the case of child or elder abuse, or threats to harm yourself or others).
- **Federal Protection:** A federal Certificate of Confidentiality protects your privacy, even from court orders.



HOW DO I PARTICIPATE?

- Anyone receiving supported psychedelic services is welcome to participate, you simply need to be 21 or over.
- Tell your facilitator that you're interested in participating in the OPEN study. They will share a unique link with you so that you can sign up.
